Program Overview

The Graduate Certificate in Trauma-Informed Practice allows for focused and integrated training in evidence-based models designed to address differential responses to trauma alongside the course and fieldwork necessary for a student's chosen concentration and specialization areas. A total of 15 credit hours is required for this certificate, which includes 9 credit hours of required course work and 6 credit hours of elective courses selected from a list of approved electives.

Program Requirements
