## Program Overview

This transcriptable certificate requires 15 credit hours of coursework, which can be counted toward an MS degree in nutrition, and a cumulative GPA of 3.0. No transfer courses or work experience may be accepted in lieu of credit courses.

- Public Health Analyst for Health Resources and Services Administration;
- Community Outreach Dietitian; and
- Nutrition Education Consultant with the Dairy and Nutrition Council.

*Students may complete either the Certificate in Maternal and Child Nutrition or the Certificate in Nutrition for Health Care Professionals but not both.*

## Program Requirements

**Certificate Requirements:** Degree-seeking students who are enrolled in the Nutrition, MS; Public Health Nutrition, MS; Public Health Nutrition Dietetic Internship; the Combined Dietetic Internship/Master's Degree Program; and the MD/MS program are eligible for this certificate.

Credits for this coursework may be double counted toward the degree program and this certificate. Students must maintain a cumulative GPA of 3.0 to obtain this certificate.

*Students may complete either the Certificate in Maternal and Child Nutrition or the Certificate in Nutrition for Health Care Professionals but not both.*
